## HISTORY

- ❖ Vignobles Lesgourgues did the resumption of the tenant farm of this estate to the Château Fieuzal in 1997.
- ❖ The wines from this terroir are known for their great reputation: they are among the favourite Graves for the natives people from Bordeaux.

## VINEYARD

- ❖ 22 hectares of vines on 25
- ❖ Production : 35 hl/ha
- ❖ Average age : 35 years
- ❖ Siliceous graves and clayey graves on a calcareous ground

## BLENDING

- ❖ 50% Merlot
- ❖ 50% Cabernet Sauvignon

## VINIFICATION

- ❖ Maceration : 15 jours
- ❖ Fermentation : 30°C
- ❖ Remontage quotidien
- ❖ Ageing: 12 months, in oak barrels

**AGEING POTENTIAL** from 5 to 8 years

## TASTING NOTES

Nice intense and red colour.  
The fruity and fresh nose offers some cherry notes with nice spicy aromas such as cinnamon.  
The rounded mouth has a balanced structure with good tanins, almost rounded.  
Nice long-lasting finish.
