Finca Cuarta Mencía 2014

Finca Cuarta is the name of the vineyard, located in the heart of the Ribeira Sacra, from which this great wine is obtained. These 50-years-old vineyards were inherited from his grandfather by Rubén Moure, which is the winemaker of this wine.

TASTING NOTES

APPEARANCE

Cherry red. High and middle layer with intense violet rim.

SMELL

Complex notes of toasted due to wood. Very intense red fruit.

PALATE

The palate is well-structured with hints of coffee and toffee, ripe red fruit. Long and persistent.

TECHNICAL FILE

Type of wine: Aged red wine (minimum 3 months in french oak barrels)

Grape Variety: 100% Mencía

D.O.: Ribeira Sacra (Spain)

Subzone: Ribeira do Miño

Alcohol: 13 %

Vinification: Grapes are cooled to 5º C with dry ice in order to obtain the maximum extraction of anthocyanins and to ensure a greater phenolic structure. After that, we carry out the alcoholic fermentation for a period of 15 days approximately and subsequently the wine is placed in french oak barrels where malolactic fermentation happens. The wine remains in barrels for a minimum of 3 months.
